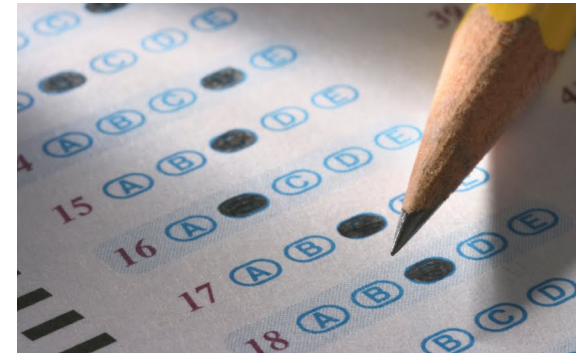

French Immersion Program – Culture & Communication

➔ **Culture & Communication 9**

- ➔ Develop oral language abilities through the exploration of various art forms from the francophone world.
- ➔ Creative arts such as drama, dance, visual arts and music
- ➔ Used to explore perspective, varied experiences and cultures in French

➔ **Culture & Communication 11**

- ➔ Continue developing oral language abilities through authentic communication and situations inspired by the Francophone world.
- ➔ Explore French culture and history through art, drama, music and various communicative experiences.
- ➔ Students who complete this course may be eligible to participate in a District trip to France.

- Preparation for entry into the majority of technical & trades programs as well as for direct entry into the work force
- Accepted for University Transfer programs (Capilano University), most colleges, & some BCIT programs

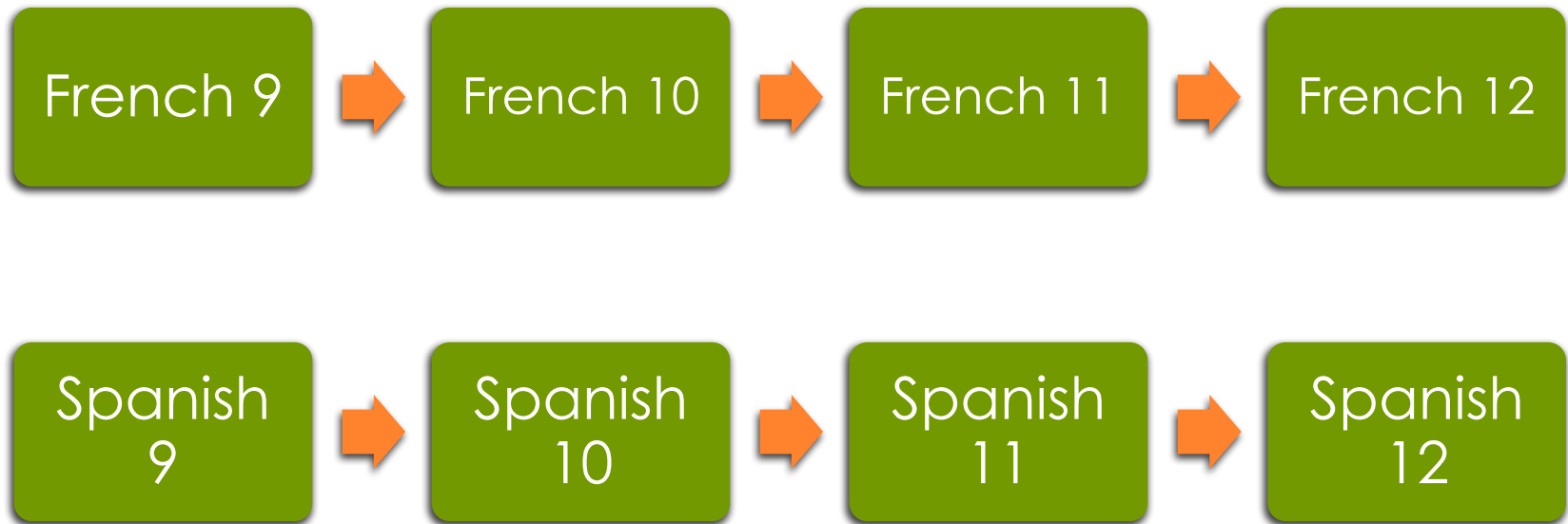

➤ **Composition:**

- Writing narrative, expository, descriptive, persuasive & opinion pieces
- Writing for specific audiences & specific disciplines
- Citing sources, consider credibility of evidence & evaluate quality & reliability of sources
